OPTIONS

Replying to a Post Once you have a registered account (UserName, DisplayName & Password), you will have the ability to reply to existing posts or topics quickly and easily. When you find a topic you would like to comment on, **look** for the **button or link** titled "**Reply**" or "**Quote**". Using "Reply" will take you to a **post page**.

Quote does exactly the same thing, however, it will add what another user has said to your post in a special box like you see above.

Starting a NEW Topic In addition to Replying to existing topics, you will have the ability to start **new topics**. To do so, navigate to a **category** you would like to begin a conversation in. Make sure that this is the correct category for the subject of your post. Once you're inside this category, search for a link or button titled "**Start New Topic**" and click it. The exact location of this button will vary depending on which template is being used, but it is often near the top of the list of topics.

Subject: This is the title of your topic and is what will be shown on the category page. You will HAVE TO type in a "Subject."

Message Icon: If you would like to add a special icon to your post, you may choose one from this list.

Add YaBBC tags: YaBBC tags give you the ability to format the text in your post. To add, simply click on the button of your choice. See the Forum "Help" page for a complete reference.

Add Smileys: Personalize your post by adding an emoticon, or smiley. Just click on the one you want and YaBB will automatically put it in your post.

Attach: You will be able to add a file to your post by clicking on the "Browse" button to find the file on your hard drive to upload. Pay attention to the allowed file types and maximum file size.

Post: (Send): Press the "**Post**" button if you're ready to **send** your message to the Forum

Preview: Press "Preview" if you would like to see what your post will look like (AND see what it says!), before you "Post" it. This allows you to revise your post and view what the formatting will look like. There is no limit to the number of times you can "Preview" a message before you "Post" it.

Reset: Press "Reset" to clear all of the boxes and start again.
